

## **Q-School Frequently Asked Questions**

### **Q: How exactly does Q-School work?**

A: It will be a one day 18-hole event played like any other tournament during the summer. Juniors will play from the same yardages that will be played throughout the summer in Major events. A percentage between 20-25% of the field will qualify for a Majors Membership following the completion of the event. A specific number of qualifiers will be released to participants prior to the event, so one will know how many spots will be available during the event.

### **Q: Do I have to be a Junior Series Member to register for Q-School?**

A: No, because this event is supposed to help decide which membership level you will be in for the summer you don't have to register for a membership until the completion of Q-School. If you would like to register for just a JET Membership starting March 1st you are more than welcome to. However, if you do qualify for Majors Membership you will be charged an extra \$25 if you qualify and choose to move to a Majors Membership for the season.

### **Q: Do you have to play in both events?**

A: No, one does not have to play in both events. They are welcome to register for the second q-school if they do not qualify through the first and would like a second chance.

### **Q: When does registration open for the Q-School Event on May 17<sup>th</sup>?**

A: Registration for the second event will open April 29<sup>th</sup> following the completion of the first q-school.

### **Q: Can a junior play in Q-School if they are younger than 13?**

A: Yes, someone who is younger and wants to qualify for the 13-15 division can try to qualify for the majors through q-school.
