

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What Division Should I Sign up for?

A: A junior can play in whatever age division they fall in on June 1st of every season and can play in that age division the entire season even if they have a birthday after that date.

Q: Can I move up an age division?

A: Yes, any junior golfer can move up an age division at any time, they cannot however move down. If one chooses to move up a division, they will be expected to play the yardages that the age group plays.

Q: Am I allowed to caddie or assist my junior during a tournament?

A: Yes, anyone over the age of 18 is allowed to caddie for their junior during any tournament excluding the PGA Junior Championship. All caddies are asked to follow the caddy guidelines. See [here](#).

Q: Can I ride around I rent a golf car and spectate during a junior event?

A: Spectators are allowed but are asked to only speak words of encouragement to their juniors, no advice from a spectator is allowed. Parents are allowed to rent golf carts (golf car rental is up to the discretion of the golf courses hosting events).

Q: Can a junior play in Q-School if they are younger than 13?

A: Yes, someone who is younger and wants to qualify for the 13-15 division can try to qualify for the majors through q-school.

Q: Can my junior need a push car or pull cart?

A: Yes, they are allowed. However, we do not provide them. Some courses have them to rent, but its recommended to call ahead to the course if you are looking to rent.

Q: What are the typical yardages juniors will play in the Majors?

A: Girls 13-15: 4800-5500 Yards

Girls 16-18: 5500-6100 Yards

Boys 13-15: 5800-6400 Yards

Boys 16-18: 6500-7000 Yards
